

Fort Saskatchewan Lions

are giving a dock to the City of Fort Saskatchewan for placement at the Fort Lions Community Fishpond. We already sponsor the Fort Lions Community Fish Pond which is a very large pond that is approx. 250 feet across and 30 feet deep. Every year the pond is stocked with 2000 trout.

This year we are donating a dock that is 8 feet wide and 60 feet long. The dock has two arms that project sideways and an enlarged circular end that will have benches. This dock will be accessible to wheelchairs, baby carriages and those who have difficulty with mobility. We already have this dock in a storage yard and are eagerly awaiting its construction in the spring. The cost of the dock is \$70,000. Stay tuned for our official opening at the end of June 2017. The Fort Lions are very proud of our Centennial project.
