# Updates from LERF (Lions Eye Research Fund)

Fundraising Update – As reported vention in the September Lions Roar, the Retcam fundraising target for sevaluating eye health of premature babies has been reached, and the device is on the way. A total of 26 Lions clubs from District C-1 contributed, and matching funds were received from the Royal Alex of Alberta Foundation.


Proposal for Next Project - At it's of October meeting LERF decided to recommend that an ERG machine might be considered for our next project recommendation. This machine is a portable electrodiagnostic machine used for making easier diagnosis of various pediatric vision conditions in a quicker and easier manner. At present making the diagnoses of some of these conditions requires children to be anesthetized first. The cost is considerably less than the Retcam - in the neighborhood of \$20,000, although this has not been confirmed. This could form a continuation of the project to help in the diagnosis of problems in children.

- International Guest PID Larry Dicus was personable, outgoing, and informative.






