# Cycling Without Age a Beaumont Lions Club Funded Project

**Beaumont Lions** have sponsored, in the amount of \$10,000 a service project that is growing in popularity due to the service it provides seniors and other shut-ins to improve their quality of life. Basically it provides open air rides on a "tricycle" that gives seniors the experience of being out in their communities and lets them interact with their "pilots", giving them much needed social intercourse. Although the feedback is anecdotal, everyone involved in the program, whether pilots or clients, are thrilled with the benefits provided to the seniors - not to mention the improved physical conditioning of the pilots...

The organization that administers and promotes the project is **Cycling Without Age** <a href="https://cyclingwithoutage.org/">https://cyclingwithoutage.org/</a>, a non-profit started in Copenhagen, Denmark, in 2012, which has now grown to 44 countries, includ-
